Out-Reach Teachers work with students referred to us by schools and the LA. You will work with our experienced Mentors during the transition period. Out-Reach Teachers develop student's confidence so they feel comfortable enough to come to our centre so we can move through our reintegration process. An Out-Reach Teacher may also have opportunities to work at our centre if desired.

Onsite Teachers teach small classes of students who are also in the process of building confidence in a classroom setting in readiness for reintegration. You will have the opportunity to teach our Electively Home-educated children and our school and LA referred students. Onsite teachers can also work as an Out-Reach Teacher if desired.

Fast Progress Tuition (FPT) is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. The successful candidate will be subject to an enhanced DBS check and satisfactory references.
